
Sashing, Block and Border Designs

Sashing

- A strip of fabric used to set pieced or appliqued blocks together is called sashing.
- If cut 3" wide, it will measure 2½" finished. The direction the seams are pressed (toward the block or under the sashing strips) determines the size of the width to be quilted.
- Outline quilting is done 14" away from the seams. In-the-ditch quilting is done on the side with no seam allowances underneath.
