

Tori's Triplet Block

Block Size: 9" Finished

Materials needed for one block:

Dark Fabric:

1 fat quarter or 10" x 16"scrap

Light Fabric:

• 1 fat quarter or 10" x 15"scrap


Cutting Instructions:

From the dark fabric, cut:

- 4 3½" x 3½" squares
- 3 4¼" x 4¼" squares

From the light fabric, cut:


- 2 3½" x 3½" squares
- 3 41/4" x 41/4" squares




Assembling the block:


1. Sew a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " dark square to each side of a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " light square as shown below. Press the seams toward the dark squares. Make two.









2. On the back of a $4\frac{1}{4}$ " light square, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner as shown below. Measuring a quarter inch from the drawn line, draw the sewing lines on each side. Make three.



3. Place a $4\frac{1}{4}$ " light square on a $4\frac{1}{4}$ " dark square, right sides together, and sew on the outer lines as shown below. Cut apart on the center line. Repeat for the other two marked light squares.







4. On the back of a half-square triangle made in step three, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner as shown below. Measuring a quarter inch from the drawn line, draw the sewing lines on each side. Repeat on three half-square triangles.




5. Place a marked half-square triangle on an unmarked half-square triangle, right sides together. Sew on the outer lines as shown below. Cut apart on the center line. Repeat for the other two marked half-square triangles. This makes three quarter-square triangles.





6. Sew the three quarter-square triangle units made in step four together as shown below. Be sure to turn them as indicated in the diagram below.



7. Assemble the rows following the diagram below:
