


## Daytona Beach Block

# 6" x 6" finished block size 6½" x 60½" unfinished row size

### Fabric Requirements:

\*If traveling to the show, pick up your favorite


fabrics to put in that show's row!

Lime: 1/8 yard Blue: 1/8 yard White: 1/3 yard

### **Cutting Instructions:**

From the width of fabric, cut:

 $3 - 1\frac{4}{1}$  lime strips  $2\frac{1}{2} - 1\frac{4}{1}$  blue strips  $11 - 1\frac{1}{8}$  white strips



#### **Block Assembly Instructions:**

1. Sew a  $1\frac{1}{8}$ " white strip to each side of the  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " lime strips. Press the seams toward the lime fabric. Cut into  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " units as shown below. Repeat with the remaining  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " blue strips. Make 50 lime and 40 blue units.




2. Sew a lime unit to each side of a blue unit as shown below. Press the seams toward the blue unit. Make 20 lime rows.



3. Sew a blue unit to each side of a lime unit as shown below. Press the seams toward the lime unit. Make 10 blue rows.



4. Sew a row made in step two to the top and bottom of the row made in step four as shown below. Make 10 blocks.



#### **Row Assembly Instructions:**

1. Sew the blocks together using the diagram below for positioning.
