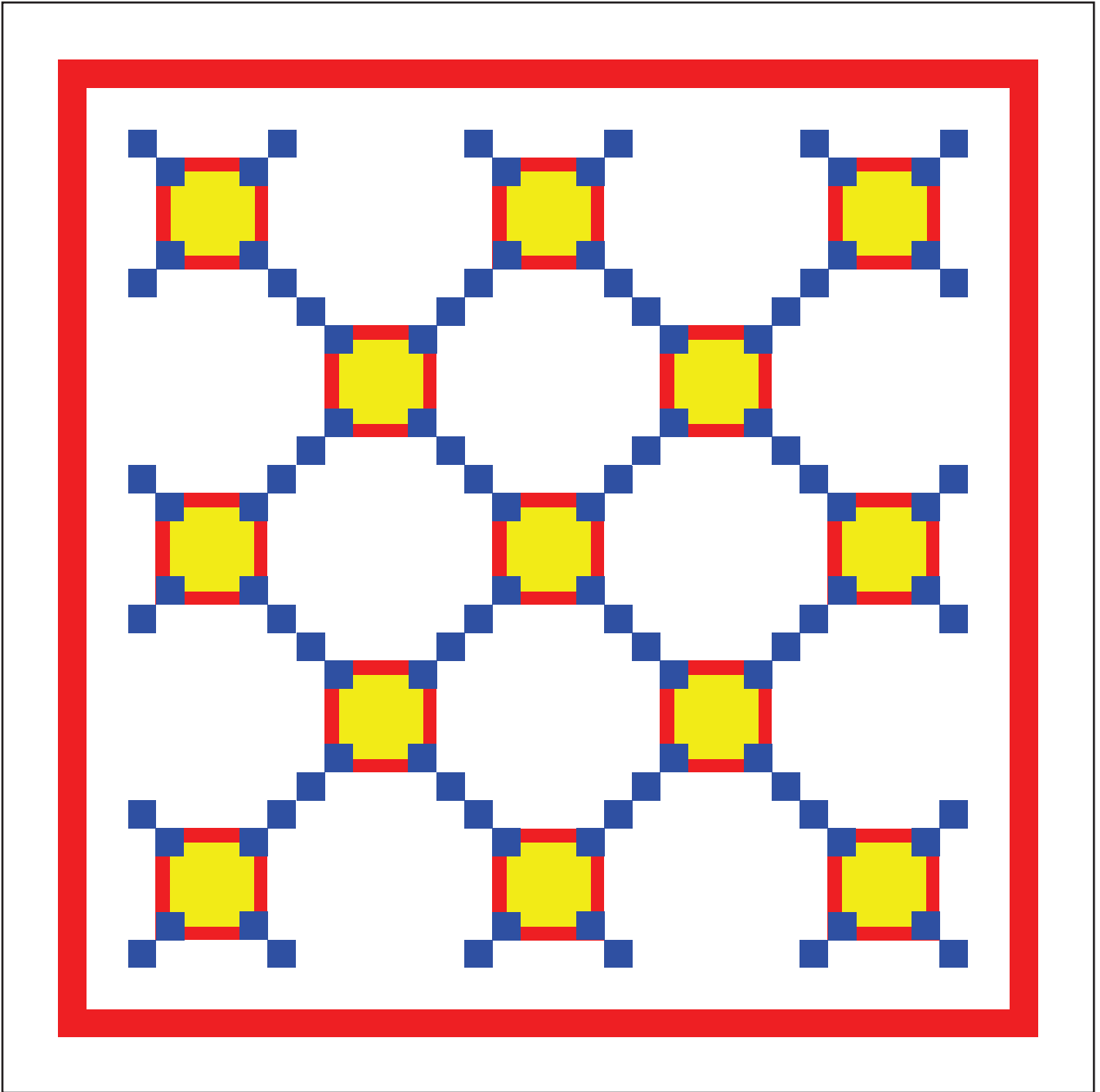


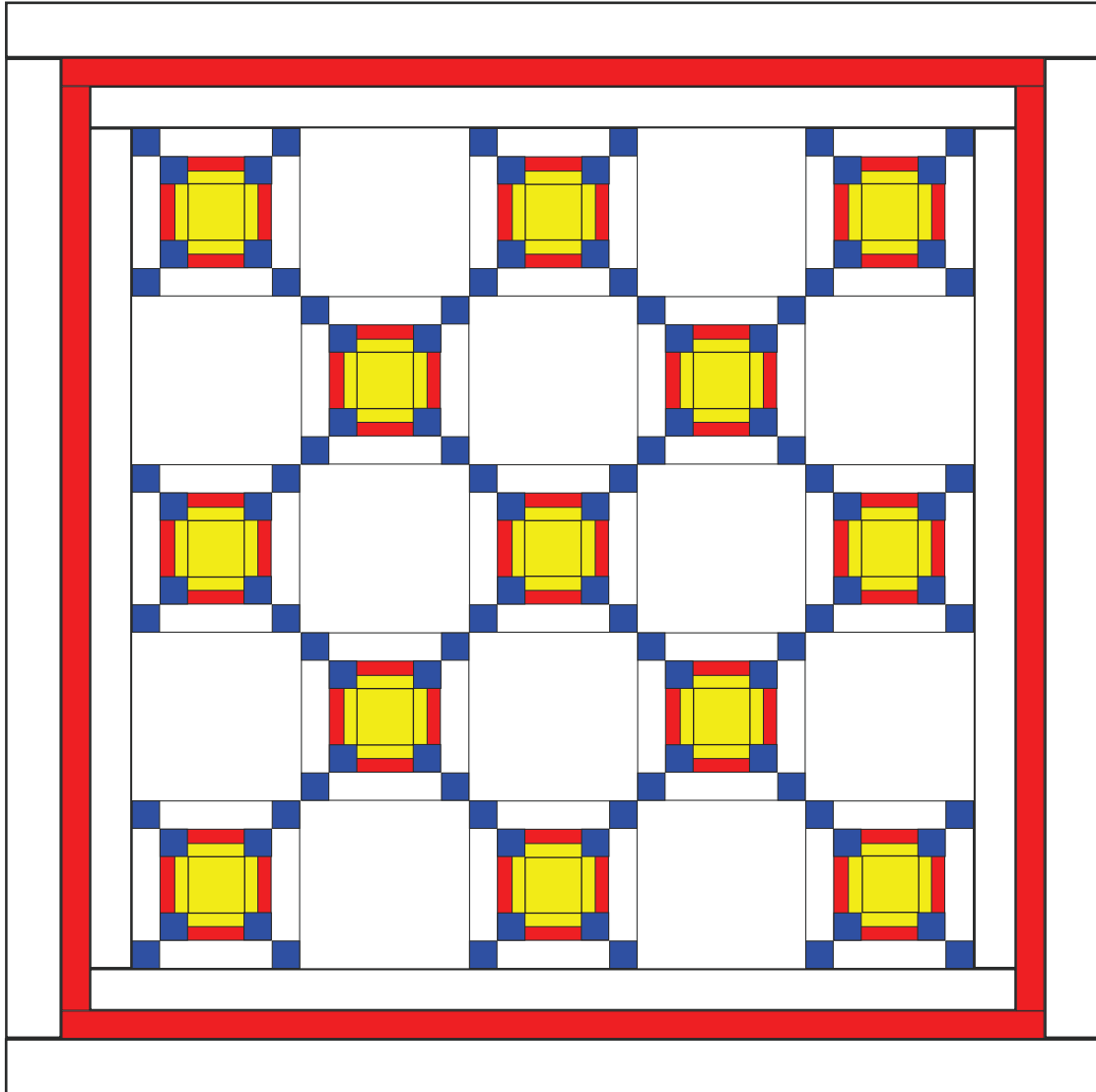
Baby Chain



Baby Chain

36" x 36"

6" finished blocks



Fabric Requirements

White – 1½ yards

Blue – ¼ yard

Red – ¼ yard

Yellow – ¼ yard

Backing – 1¼ yards

Binding – 1/3 yard

Cutting Instructions

From the white fabric, cut:

1 – 4½" strip from the width of the fabric

26 – 1½" x 4½" rectangles

12 – 6½" x 6½" squares

4 – 1½" strips from the width of the fabric

4 – 2" strips from the width of the fabric

From the blue fabric, cut:

2 – 1½" strips from the width of the fabric

52 – 1½" x 1½" squares

From the red fabric, cut:

8 – 1" strips from the width of the fabric

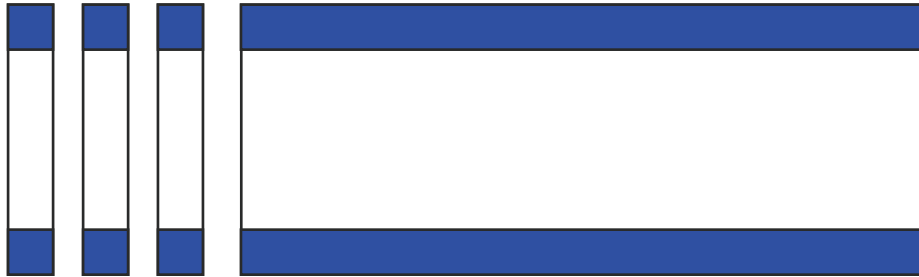
From the yellow fabric, cut:

4 – 1" strips from the width of the fabric

13 – 2½" x 2½" squares

Assembly Instructions

1. Sew a 1½" blue strip to the top and bottom of the 4½" white strip. Cut into 1½" segments as shown below. Repeat with the remaining blue and white strips. Make 26.



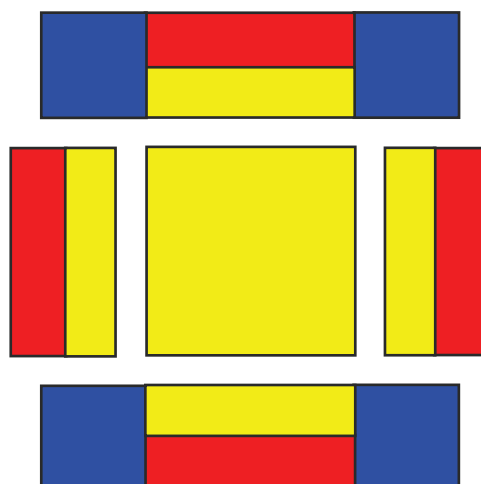
2. Sew a 1" red strip to the side of a 1" yellow strip. Cut into 2½" segments as shown below. Repeat with three more red and yellow strips. Make 52.



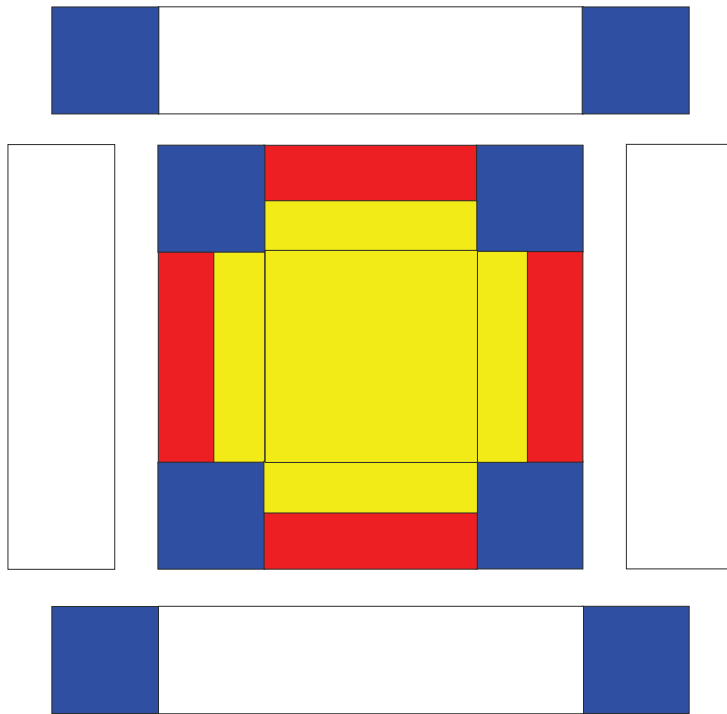
3. Sew a 1½" blue square to the ends of 26 of the segments made in step two as shown below. Make 26.



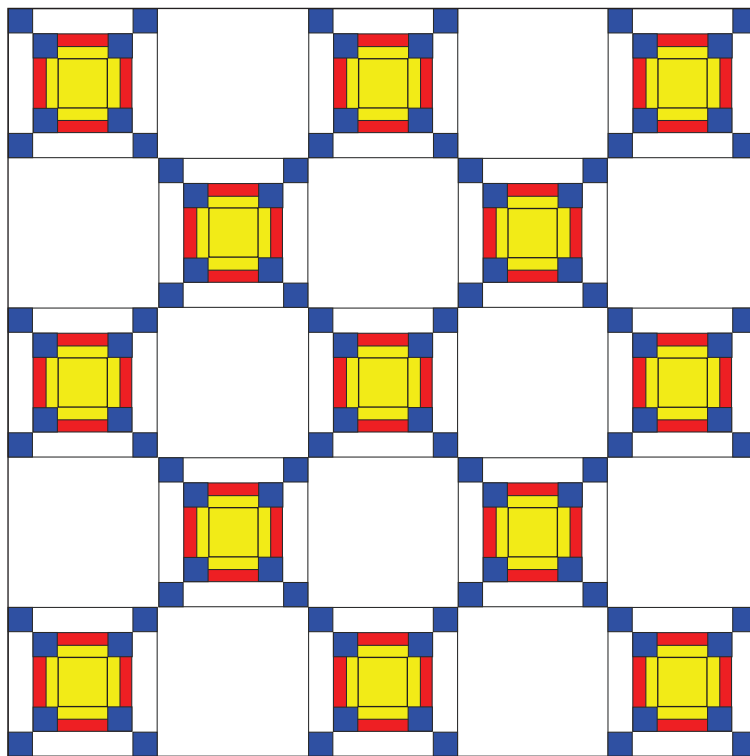
4. Sew the inside of the Baby Chain Block together as shown below. Make 13.



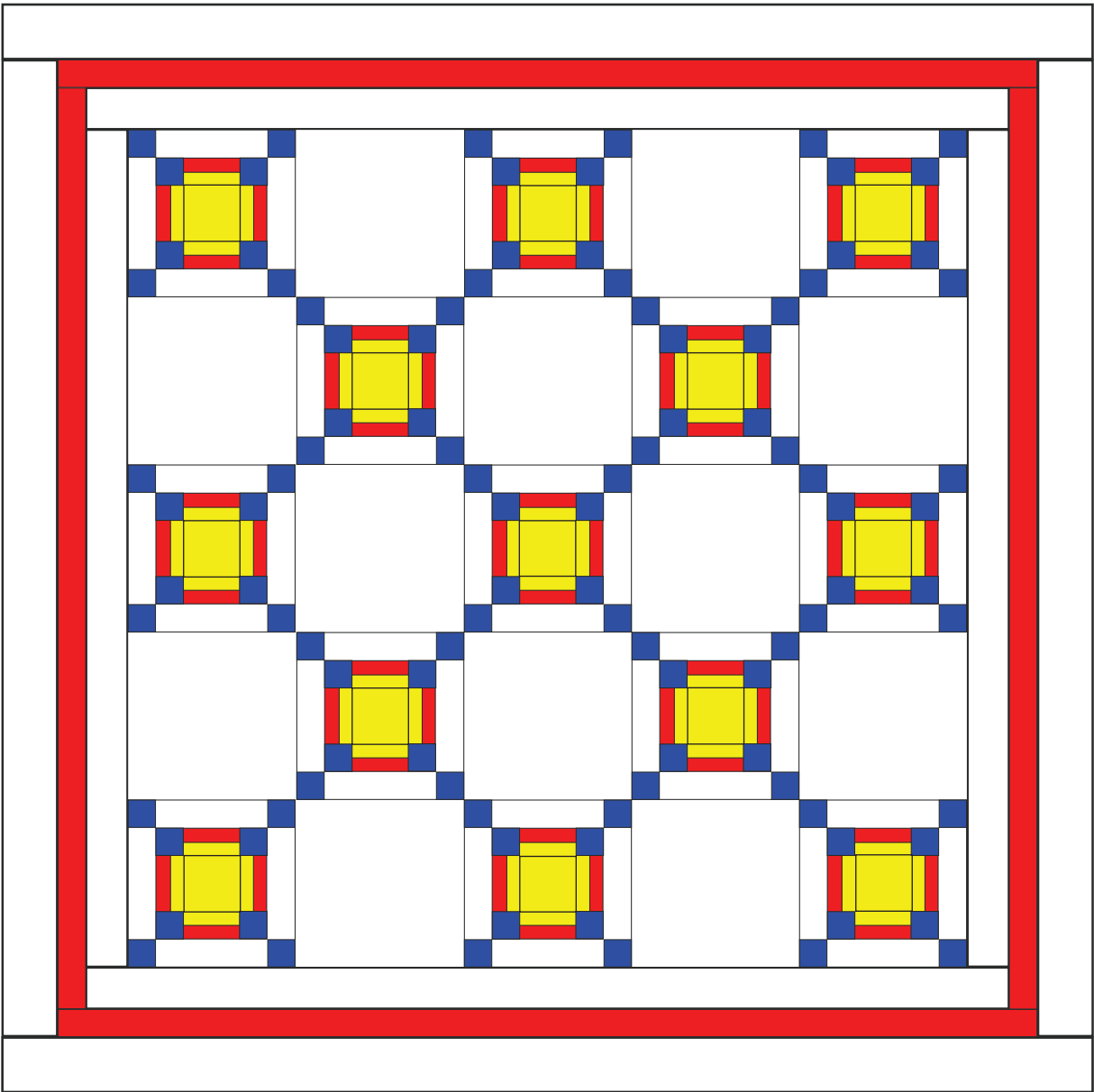
5. Complete the Baby Chain Block as shown below. Make 13.



6. Sew the 13 Baby Chain blocks to the 6½" white setting squares as shown below.



7. Measure the width of the quilt center in three locations. Average the three measurements and cut two of the 1½" white strips to this length. Sew to the sides of the quilt center. Repeat this process with the top strips. After adding and pressing each border, repeat for the remaining 1" red border and final 2" outer white border.



8. Quilt as desired
