


# AQS QuiltWeek Row #3

## Lancaster Block 10" x 10" finished block size 101/2" x 601/2" unfinished row size

### Fabric Requirements:


\*If traveling to the show, pick up your favorite fabrics to put in that show's row! Teal: ½ yard Orange: ¼ yard White: 3/8 yard

### Cutting Instructions:

From the teal fabric, cut:  $24 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " teal squares 2 - 3" strips from the width of the fabric

From the orange fabric, cut:  $12 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From the white fabric, cut:  $12 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " white squares 2 - 3" white strips




#### **Block Assembly Instructions:**


1. 1. Sew a 3" teal strip to a 3" white strip. Press the seams toward the teal fabric. Cut into 3" segments. Repeat with the remaining teal and white strips. Make 24 segments.




2. Draw a diagonal line once from corner to corner on the wrong side of the white  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.




3. With right sides together, layer a marked 3½" white square on top of a 3½" teal square. Sew a ¼" seam on both sides of the line, then cut apart on the drawn line. Press seams toward the teal side. Size the squares to 3". Repeat with the remaining 3½" white squares and 3½" teal squares. Makes 24 white/teal half-square triangles.



4. Draw a diagonal line once from corner to corner on the wrong side of the orange 3½" squares.




5. With right sides together, layer a marked 3½" orange square on top of a 3½" teal square. Sew a ¼" seam on both sides of the line, then cut apart on the drawn line. Press seams toward the teal side. Size the squares to 3". Repeat with the remaining 3½" orange squares and 3½" teal squares. Makes 12 orange/teal half-square triangles.




#### **Row Assembly Instructions:**

1. Sew the units from steps one, three, and five together using the diagram below for positioning. Make 40 quarter blocks.



2. Sew the quarter blocks into blocks. Make 6 blocks. Size to  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".



3. Sew the blocks together to make the Lancaster Row.
