# Lancaster Block 

$10^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ finished block size
$101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 601 / 2 "$ unfinished row size

## Fabric Requirements:

*If traveling to the show, pick up your favorite fabrics to put in that show's row!
Teal: $1 / 2$ yard
Orange: $1 / 4$ yard
White: 3/8 yard
Cutting Instructions:
From the teal fabric, cut:
$24-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ teal squares
$2-3$ " strips from the width of the fabric
From the orange fabric, cut:
$12-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3 ½$ " squares
From the white fabric, cut:

$12-3 \frac{1 ⁄ 2}{2} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white squares
$2-3^{\prime \prime}$ white strips

## Block Assembly Instructions:

1. 2. Sew a $3^{\prime \prime}$ teal strip to a $3^{\prime \prime}$ white strip. Press the seams toward the teal fabric. Cut into $3^{\prime \prime}$ segments. Repeat with the remaining teal and white strips. Make 24 segments.

1. Draw a diagonal line once from corner to corner on the wrong side of the white $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

2. With right sides together, layer a marked $31 / 2$ " white square on top of a $31 / 2$ " teal square. Sew a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on both sides of the line, then cut apart on the drawn line. Press seams toward the teal side. Size the squares to $3^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat with the remaining $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white squares and $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ teal squares. Makes 24 white/teal half-square triangles.

3. Draw a diagonal line once from corner to corner on the wrong side of the orange $31 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

4. With right sides together, layer a marked $31 / 2$ " orange square on top of a $31 / 2$ " teal square. Sew a $1 / 4$ " seam on both sides of the line, then cut apart on the drawn line. Press seams toward the teal side. Size the squares to $3^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat with the remaining $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ orange squares and $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ teal squares. Makes 12 orange/teal half-square triangles.


## Row Assembly Instructions:

1. Sew the units from steps one, three, and five together using the diagram below for positioning. Make 40 quarter blocks.

2. Sew the quarter blocks into blocks. Make 6 blocks. Size to $10 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

3. Sew the blocks together to make the Lancaster Row.
