

Phoenix Block

6" x 6" finished block size

6½" x 60½" unfinished row size

Fabric Requirements:

*If traveling to the show, pick up your favorite fabrics to put in that show's row!

Magenta: ¼ yard

Lime: ¼ yard

White: ¼ yard

Cutting Instructions:

From the magenta fabric, cut:

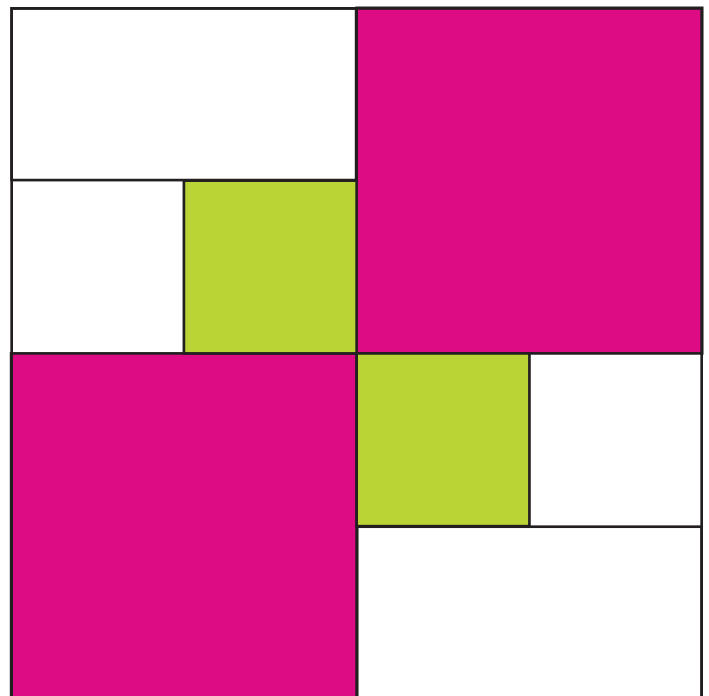
- 10 – 3½" x 3½" squares
- 1 – 2" x 20" strip

From the lime fabric, cut:

- 10 – 3½" x 3½" squares
- 1 – 2" x 20" strip

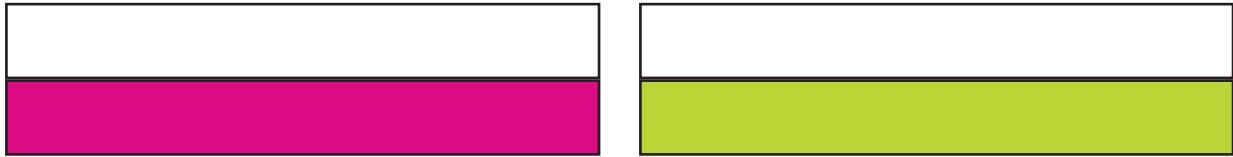
From the white fabric, cut:

- 2 – 2" x 20" strips
- 20 – 2" x 3½" rectangles

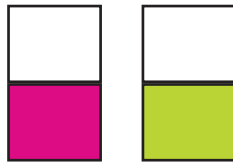


Block Assembly Instructions:

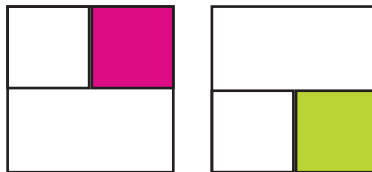
1. Sew a 2" x 20" magenta strip to a 2" x 20" white strip. Repeat with the remaining lime and white strip. Press seams toward the colored side.



2. Cut the strips made in step one into 2" segments. Cut 10 segments from each strip.



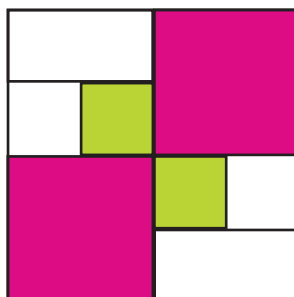
3. Sew a segment made in step two to a 2" x 3½" white rectangle. Press the seams toward the white rectangle. Make 10 magenta units and 10 lime units.



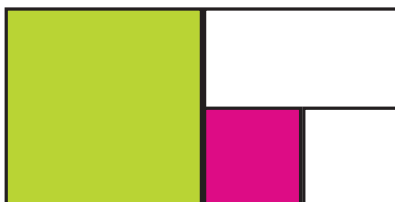
4. Sew a lime unit made in step three to a magenta 3½" x 3½" square following the diagram below. Press the seams toward the magenta square. Make 10.



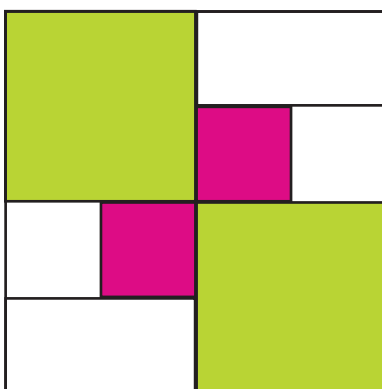
5. Sew two units made in step four together following the diagram below. Press the seams toward the magenta squares. Make 5.



6. Sew a magenta unit made in step three to a lime $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square following the diagram below. Press the seams toward the lime square. Make 10.



7. Sew two units made in step four together following the diagram below. Press the seams toward the lime squares. Make 5.

8. Alternating the magenta and lime blocks, sew the blocks together following the diagram below.
