# Phoenix Block <br> 6" $\times 6$ " finished block size <br> $6 ½ " \times 601 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished row size 

## Fabric Requirements:

*If traveling to the show, pick up your favorite fabrics to put in that show's row! Magenta: $1 / 4$ yard Lime: $1 / 4$ yard White: $1 / 4$ yard

Cutting Instructions:
From the magenta fabric, cut:

- $10-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
- $1-2$ " $\times 20$ " strip

From the lime fabric, cut:

- $10-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

- 1-2" x 20 " strip

From the white fabric, cut:

- $2-2$ " x 20 " strips
- 20-2" x $31 / 2$ " rectangles


## Block Assembly Instructions:

1. Sew a $2^{\prime \prime} \times 20 "$ magenta strip to a $2 " \times 20 "$ white strip. Repeat with the remaining lime and white strip. Press seams toward the colored side.

2. Cut the strips made in step one into 2 " segments. Cut 10 segments from each strip.

3. Sew a segment made in step two to a 2 " $\times 31 / 2$ " white rectangle. Press the seams toward the white rectangle. Make 10 magenta units and 10 lime units.

4. Sew a lime unit made in step three to a magenta $31 / 2$ " $\times 3^{1 / 2 "}$ square following the diagram below. Press the seams toward the magenta square. Make 10.

5. Sew two units made in step four together following the diagram below. Press the seams toward the magenta squares. Make 5.

6. Sew a magenta unit made in step three to a lime $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{1 / 2 "}$ " square following the diagram below. Press the seams toward the lime square. Make 10.

7. Sew two units made in step four together following the diagram below. Press the seams toward the lime squares. Make 5.

8. Alternating the magenta and lime blocks, sew the blocks together following the diagram below.
