# Chattanooga Row $10^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ finished block size $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 601 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished row size 



## Fabric Requirements:

*If traveling to the show, pick up your favorite fabrics to put in that show's row!
White: $1 / 4$ yard
Lime: $1 / 3$ yard
Blue: $1 / 8$ yard

Cutting Instructions:
From the white fabric, cut:
$4-11 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ width of fabric (WOF) strips
From the lime fabric, cut:
$6-11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips
From the blue fabric, cut:
$2-1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips

## Block Assembly Instructions:

1. Sew a $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blue strip to a $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ lime strip. Press seams toward the blue fabric.

2. Cut the strip sets made in step one into $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ segments. Cut 30 .

3. Sew a $11 / 2 "$ lime strip to a $11 / 2 "$ white strip. Press seams toward the lime fabric.

4. Cut the strip sets made in step three into $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ segments. Make 60.

5. Arrange row one as shown below, and sew together.

6. Arrange row two as shown below, and sew together.

7. Arrange row three as shown below, and sew together.
