

AQS QuiltWeek Row #8

Des Moines Row

$6" \times 6"$ finished block size $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 60\frac{1}{2}"$ unfinished row size



Fabric Requirements:

*If traveling to the show, pick up your favorite fabrics to put in that show's row!

White: 1/4 yard Teal: 1/4 yard Orange: 1/8 yard

Cutting Instructions:

From the white fabric, cut: 20 – 4" x 4" squares

From the teal fabric, cut: 15 – 4" x 4" squares


From the orange fabric, cut: 5 - 4" x 4" squares

Block Assembly Instructions:

1. Draw a diagonal line once from corner to corner on the wrong side of 20 white 4" squares.



2. With right sides together, layer a marked 4" white square on top of a 4" teal square. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both sides of the line, then cut apart on the drawn line. Press seams toward the teal side. Size the squares to $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat with the remaining 4" teal squares and the 5 – 4" orange squares.





3. Arrange the squares made in step two into the teal and orange row. Sew the squares together as shown below.



4. Arrange the remaining square made in step two into a teal row. Sew the squares together as shown below.



Row Assembly Instructions:

1. Sew the rows together as shown below.
