## Sunshine \& Rainbows



## Fabric Requirements

We used some our beloved American Jane scraps.
Yellow Sun - $1 / 2$ yard
Rainbows $-3^{\prime \prime} \times 15^{\prime \prime}$ scraps of four different colors
Center - 4" square scrap
Background - 3/4 yard

## Cutting Instructions

Yellow Sun -
$4-61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares
4-7" $\times 7^{\text {" }}$ squares

## Rainbows -

$1-2^{\prime \prime} \times 15^{\prime \prime}$ strip from four different fabrics
Center -
$1-3 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2$ " square


Background -
4 - $61 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ squares
4-7" $\times 7^{\prime \prime}$ squares
$4-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

## Assembly Construction

1. Mark a line down the center of the back of the $7^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$ white squares. Mark a line $1 / 4$ " on each side of the center line.

2. Layer a $7^{\prime \prime} \times 7$ " sunshine square with a 7 " $\times 7^{\prime \prime}$ marked white square, right sides together. Sew down the two outer lines on the background square.

3. Cut the half squares apart on the center line.

4. Press the half square open and evenly trim the block to $61 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{1 / 2 "}$ square.

5. Sew the units made in the previous step to the $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ white and sunshine squares as shown below.


Make 4.
6. Sew the units made in the previous step together, as shown below.

7. Sew the $2^{\prime \prime} \times 15^{\prime \prime}$ colored strips together and trim cut them into $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ segments.

8. Sew the segment made in the previous step to the $31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background rectangle as shown below.

9. Sew the block units into rows and sew the block together.
