Sunshine & Rainbows

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27" Finished Block Size
(27½" unfinished)

Fabric Requirements

We used some our beloved American Jane scraps.

Yellow Sun – ½ yard

Rainbows – 3" x 15" scraps of four different colors

Center – 4" square scrap

Background – ¾ yard

Cutting Instructions

Yellow Sun –

4 – 6½" x 6½" squares

4 – 7" x 7" squares

Rainbows –

1 – 2" x 15" strip from four different fabrics

Center –

1 – 3½" x 3½" square

Background –

4 – 6½" x 6½" squares

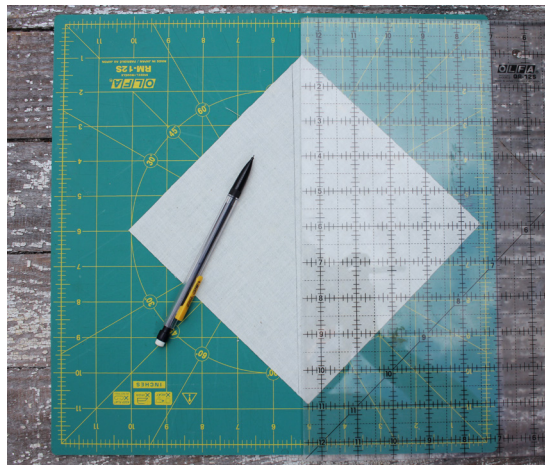
4 – 7" x 7" squares

4 – 3½" x 6½" rectangles

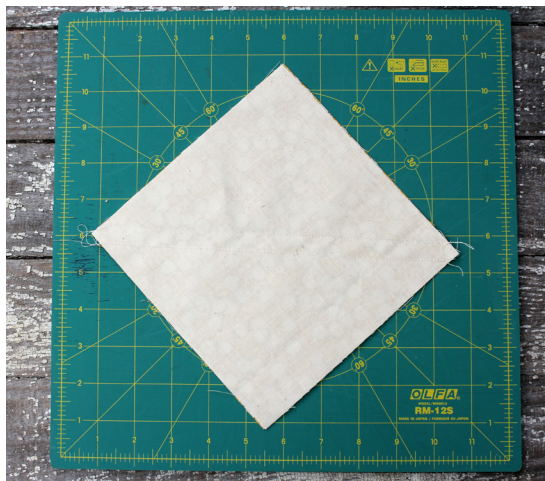


Assembly Construction

1. Mark a line down the center of the back of the 7" x 7" white squares. Mark a line ¼" on each side of the center line.



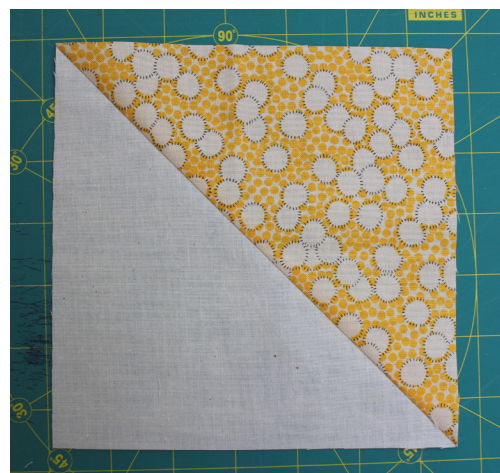
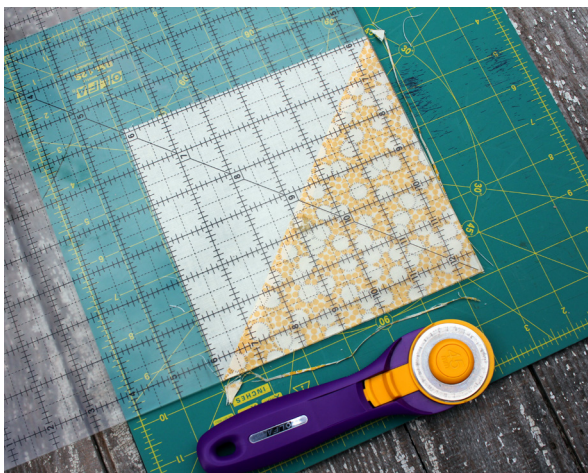
2. Layer a 7" x 7" sunshine square with a 7" x 7" marked white square, right sides together. Sew down the two outer lines on the background square.



- Cut the half squares apart on the center line.



- Press the half square open and evenly trim the block to 6½" x 6½" square.



- Sew the units made in the previous step to the 6½" x 6½" white and sunshine squares as shown below.



Make 4.

6. Sew the units made in the previous step together, as shown below.



7. Sew the 2" x 15" colored strips together and trim cut them into 3½" segments.



8. Sew the segment made in the previous step to the 3½" x 6½" background rectangle as shown below.



9. Sew the block units into rows and sew the block together.
