## Block 2019

## Basket

## Fabric Requirements:

Gray - $3 / 8$ yard
Aqua - $1 / 8$ yard
Dark Blue - $1 / 8$ yard
Coral - $1 / 8$ yard
Batting - $12^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$

## Cutting Instructions:

From the gray fabric, cut:
(1) $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (For the quilt-as-you-go method only, do not cut otherwise.)
(14) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(8) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$

From the aqua fabric, cut:
(12) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

From the dark blue fabric, cut:
(8) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$

From the coral fabric, cut:
(6) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Cutting Guide:



## Assembly:

Half Square Triangles
Mark the wrong side of the coral $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked coral square over an aqua $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, right sides together. Sew a quarter inch from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to $2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
Make 4.


Make the following additional Half Square Triangle combinations:

- (8) coral/dark blue
- (8) gray/dark blue
- (20) gray/aqua


Make 4 individual baskets. Basket unit measures $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.


## Block Assembly

Arrange the basket units as shown above.
Sew in rows and press in opposite directions.
Sew the rows together to complete the block.
Block measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished.
To prepare the block for quilt-as-you-go, sandwich the $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ backing square, $12^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ batting centered on the backing square, and your block. Baste using preferred method. Quilt as desired inside the $12^{\prime \prime}$ finished size of the block.
