

## **BLOCK 16**

## CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:  $(4) 2'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}$ "


From the coral fabric, cut: (4) 2" x 2"

From the yellow fabric, cut:

- (1) 31/2" x 31/2"
- (4) 2" x 2"

## SQUARE IN A SQUARE (SIAS) UNIT


Mark the wrong side of 4 coral 2" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over the corner of a yellow 3½" square, right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press.



Repeat on the remaining corners with the marked squares to make an SIAS unit. Make 1.

## **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished.
