## BLOCK 31

### CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:  
(4) 2" x 2"

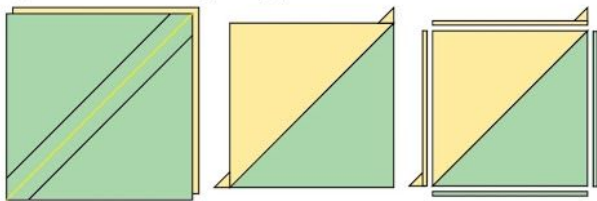
From the coral fabric, cut:  
(4) 2" x 3½"

From the yellow fabric, cut:  
(1) 3½" x 3½"  
(2) 2½" x 2½"  
(8) 2" x 2"

From the green fabric, cut:  
(2) 2½" x 2½"

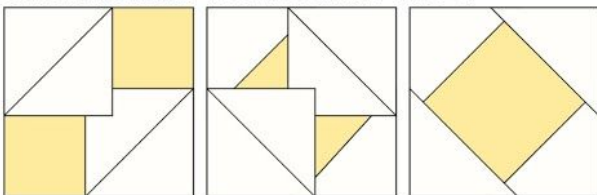
### HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS

Mark the wrong side of the green 2½" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a yellow 2½" square, right sides together. Sew a ¼" from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to 2" square. Make 4 green/yellow HST.



### SQUARE IN A SQUARE (SIAS) UNIT

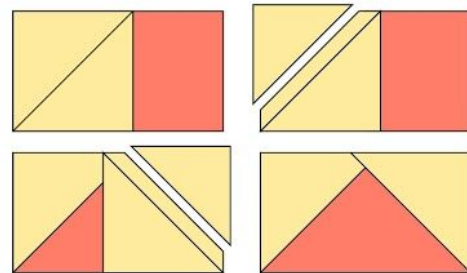
Mark 4 white 2" squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over the corner of a yellow 3½" square. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the remaining corners to make an SIAS unit. Make 1.



### FLYING GEESSE UNITS

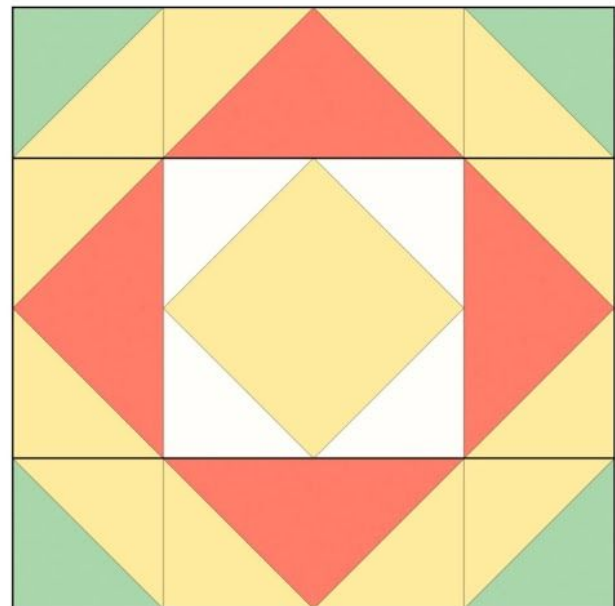
Mark the wrong side of two yellow 2" square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square with a coral 2" x 3½" rectangle, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a ¼" seam and press. Repeat on the other side with another yellow 2" square.

Make 4 coral/yellow Flying Geese units.



### BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures 6½" x 6½" unfinished.
