BLOCK 36

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:
(4) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$

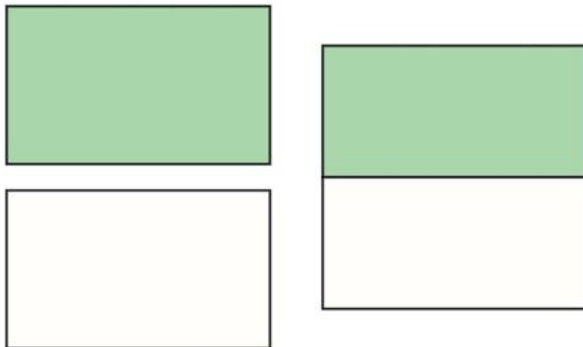
From the coral fabric, cut:
(4) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$
(4) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$

From the yellow fabric, cut:
(1) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$
(4) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$

From the green fabric, cut:
(4) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$

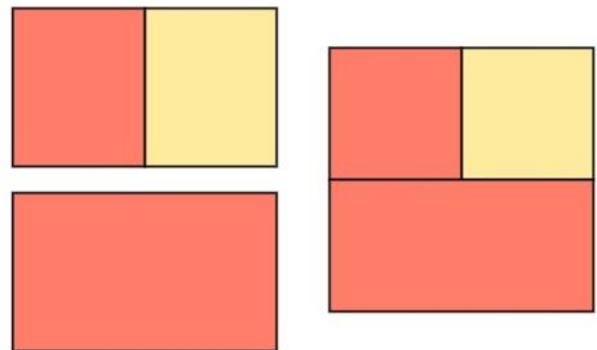
RAIL UNITS

Arrange a green and a white $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle as shown below. Sew together on the long side. Rail unit measures $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ unfinished. Make 4.



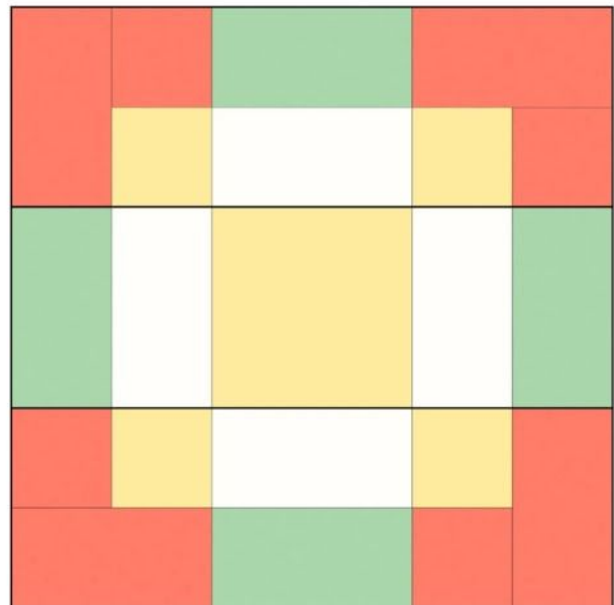
CORNER UNITS

Arrange a coral and a yellow $1\frac{1}{2}''$ square, and a coral $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle as shown below. Sew the squares together in pairs and press. Then sew the rectangle to the pairs. Corner unit measures $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ unfinished. Make 4.



BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ unfinished.
