BLOCK 25

CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

(4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

(8) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the coral fabric, cut:

(5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the yellow fabric, cut:

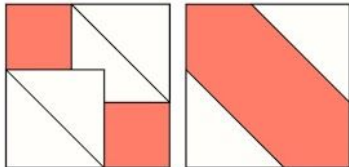
(4) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the green fabric, cut:

(8) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ "

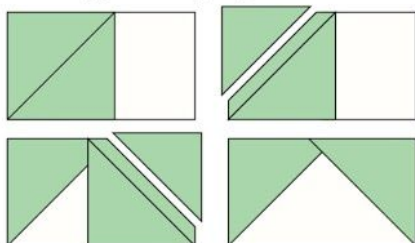
HALF SNOWBALL UNITS

Mark the wrong side of two white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a coral $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Sew on the marked line. Trim a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and press. Repeat on the diagonally opposite corner. Make 4.



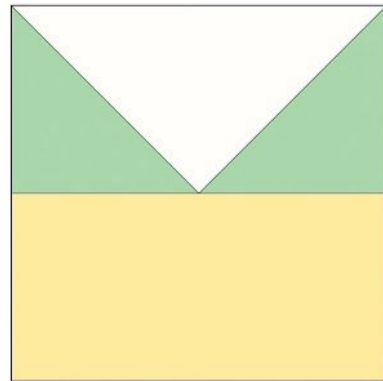
FLYING GEESSE UNITS

Mark the wrong side of a green $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square in half diagonally once. Lay the marked square on a white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, oriented as shown below. Sew on the marked line. Trim a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and press. Repeat on the other side with another marked green $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make 4 white/green Flying Geese units.



STAR POINT UNITS

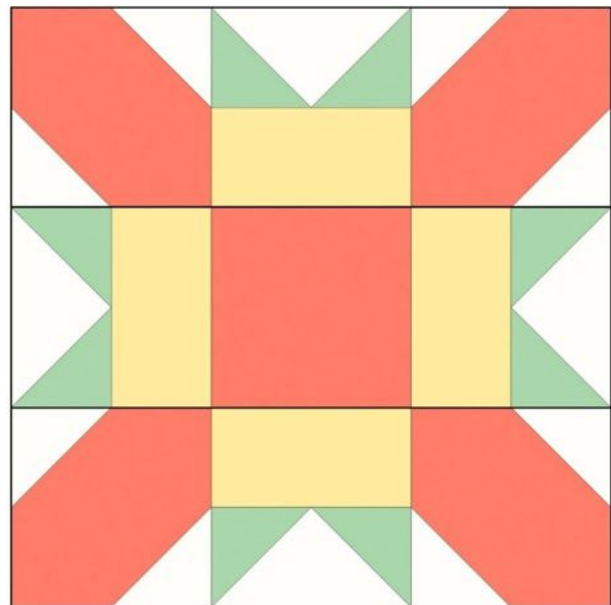
Arrange a Flying Geese unit and a yellow $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle as shown below. Sew together and press.



Star Point unit measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 4.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
