## BLOCK 26

### CUTTING

From the white fabric, cut:

(2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

(4) 2" x 2"

From the coral fabric, cut:

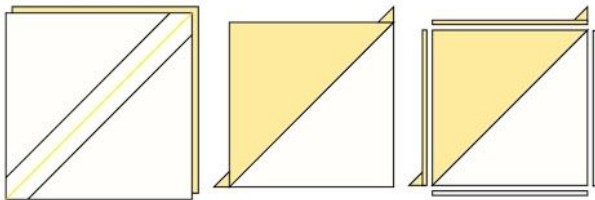
(4) 2" x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the yellow fabric, cut:

(2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

### HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE (HST) UNITS

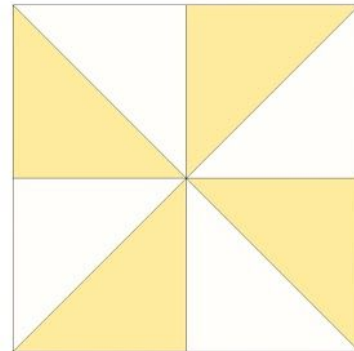
Mark the wrong side of the white  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares in half diagonally once. Lay a marked square over a yellow  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, right sides together. Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Trim unit to 2" square.



Make 4 white/yellow HST.

### PINWHEEL UNIT

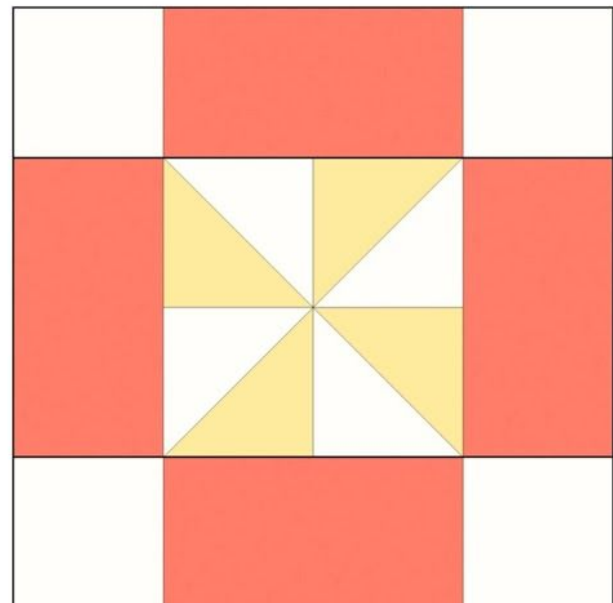
Arrange the 4 white/yellow HST into a Pinwheel as shown below. Sew together in pairs and press, then sew the pairs together.



Pinwheel unit measures  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 1.

### BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use the block diagram below to lay the block out. Sew all the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the block.



Block measures  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
