Skill Level: Easy Finished Quilt Size: 60" $\times 60^{\prime \prime}$ : Finished Block Size: 24 " $\times 24$ "

## Materials

Note: Requirements are based on 42" usable width of fabric (WOF).

White solid - $\mathbf{2 1}^{1 / 3}$ yards
Blue tone-on-tone - $7 / 8$ yard
Red tone-on-tone - 3/4 yard

Binding - $1 / 2$ yard
Backing - 41/8 yards
Batting - 68" x 68"

## Cutting

Note: All strips are cut across the WOF.
From the white solid:
6 strips 4½" x WOF (border \#2)
16 squares 7" x 7" (A)
16 squares $6^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 22^{\prime \prime}(E)$
32 rectangles $2^{11 / 2 " 1} \times 41122^{\prime \prime}$ (C)
From the blue tone-on-tone:
16 squares $7{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 7$ " (A)
4 squares $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{11 / 2 " ~(D)}$
From the red tone-on-tone:
5 strips $2^{11 / 2 " ~} \times$ WOF (border \#1)
16 squares $41 / 1^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}(B)$
16 squares $2^{1 ⁄ 2 "} \times 2^{11 / 2 "}(\mathrm{D})$

## Binding:

7 strips $21 / 41 \times$ WOF
Backing:
2 panels 35" x 68"

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## Cutting:

AccuQuilt dies can save time when cutting the following pieces:

GO! Qube Mix \& Match 8" Block (Shapes 1, 2, 8) or: $B$ squares $=G O$ ! Square $-41 / 22^{\prime \prime}(55708)$

C rectangles $=$ GO! Rectangle- $2^{11 / 2 "} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}(55715)$
D squares = GO! Square- $\mathbf{2 ¹}^{1 / 2 " 1}(55709)$
A squares $=$ GO! Half Square Triangle- 6½" (55001)
E squares $=$ GO! Square- $61 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}(55000)$
Border \#1 = GO! Strip Cutter- $\mathbf{2 ¹ ⁄ 2}^{1 / 2}$ (55017)
Border \#2 = GO! Strip Cutter- 4½" (55054)
Binding $=$ GO! Strip Cutter- $\mathbf{2 ¹ ⁄ 2}^{\text {" }}$ (55053)
*In some cases, die cutting may require slightly more or less yardage than listed in this pattern.

## Piecing the blocks

Note: Press seam allowances in the direction of the arrows.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each white A square. Place a marked square on a blue A square, right sides together (fig. 1). Sew $1 / 4$ " from each side of the marked line; cut on the marked line. Repeat to make 32 half-square triangle (HST) units. Trim each to $61 / 2$ " square, centering the diagonal seam lines.

Arrange 1 red $B$ square, 2 white $C$ rectangles, and 1 red $D$ square in 2 rows (fig. 2). Sew each row and then join the rows to make Unit F, measuring $61 / 2$ " square from raw edge to raw edge. Make 16 Unit F.

Referring to figure 3, arrange and sew 4 rows using 4 white E squares, 8 HST units, and 4 F units. Join the rows to complete a block measuring $241 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make 4 blocks.

## Assembling the quilt

Referring to the quilt assembly diagram, sew 2 rows of 2 blocks each, watching rotation. Join the rows to complete the quilt center.

Join the red border \#1 strips into one long strip. From the pieced strip, cut 4 G strips $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Sew 2 G strips to the sides of the quilt center. Add a blue $D$ square to each end of the remaining $G$ strips and sew the pieced strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

Join the white border \#2 strips into one long strip. From the pieced strip cut 2 H strips $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 52^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and 2 I strips $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 601 / 22^{\prime \prime}$. Sew the H strips to the quilt sides and the I strips to the top and bottom.

## Quilting \& finishing

Layer the backing, batting, and quilt top. Baste to secure. I machine quilted Perfectly Patriotic using the Diamonds Are Forever pantograph by Patricia E. Ritter for Urban Elementz.

Sew the binding strips together for continuous binding. Finish the edges of your quilt with double-fold binding.
